Disclosure for Clinical Supervision

I hold the PhD degree and M.S.W. degree from the University of Denver Graduate School of Social Work; and the B.A. degree from the University of Colorado. My clinical experience has been in the areas of addressing Attachment, Post-adoption, International adoption, Anxiety & Depression, adjustment of immigrants and refugees, and Grief & Loss. I have specialized serving adoptees of all ages (domestic, transracial, and international), children in foster care, adolescents in juvenile justice, children in low-income families, and families who have moved to the United States from other countries.

You are entitled to receive information about my methods of clinical supervision, the techniques I use, our contracted duration of your supervision, and my fees. I encourage you to discuss your progress in supervision with me at any time. You may also seek a second opinion from another clinical social worker if you wish to do so. You may end clinical supervision with me at any time although it is preferred that you allow for one final termination session to evaluate our work together.

In a professional relationship, such as ours, sexual intimacy or contact is never appropriate. It is illegal and should be reported to the State Grievance Board. Generally speaking, the information provided by you is legally confidential. There are a few exceptions, including criminal or delinquency proceedings, serious danger to self or others, and child abuse. If you disclose similar information about clients, you are advised that it is your responsibility per Colorado Statutes that you report this information to the appropriate authorities.

In the supervisory relationship, you are the client and you hold the privilege in terms of confidential information. I record session notes informally and maintain a formal record of brief summaries of your progress. The session notes are destroyed after each session. Summary records are kept on an electronic database for 7 years and are then destroyed. Information obtained in the supervisory relationship will not be disclosed to any person or party except 1) with your written consent; 2) in case of your death, your personal representative may request the information; 3) you communicate the contemplation or commission of a crime or harmful act; 4) if you waive the confidentiality privilege by bringing charges against the clinical supervisor; and 5) in response to a subpoena.
